

READING THROUGH THE BIBLE IN 2010

Open my eyes, that I may behold wonderful things from Your law. –Psalm 119:18

Will you join us as we take up the challenge to read through the entire Bible in one year? On average we will read four chapters a day, perhaps taking 20 minutes. A small commitment of time for such great rewards! As we encounter the whole scope of the Scripture, count on God unfolding wonderful things from His word to strengthen and encourage our souls!

Here are some Options:

- 1) In the downstairs hallway beneath the sanctuary, pick up a free copy of the little booklet *More Precious Than Gold*, which features Robert Murray McCheyne's guide for reading through the Scripture. This plan takes us through the Psalms and the NT twice, and the rest of the OT once, over the course of the year.
- 2) Read the Bible cover to cover, at your pace, but in twelve months.
- 3) Utilize one of many web resources, such as:
 - a. www.esv.org/biblereadingplans – Ten differing methods for reading through the Bible in the English Standard Version.
 - b. www.ewordtoday.com/year – Five plans and over fifty translations.

Especially for Children:

- 1) *The One-Year Bible for Kids, Challenge Edition* (NLT, Tyndale Kids). For ages 8–12.
- 2) *The One Year Bible for Children* (Tyndale Kids). For ages 5–8.
- 3) Use the Complete Bible on CD: *The Word of Promise* (Thomas Nelson Publishers). Quality readings by over 500 actors. Great for kids!
